





Ground Ambulance Balance Billing Report vssl Provider Survey

RCW 48.49.190 directs the Office of the Insurance Commissioner, in collaboration with the Washington State Department of Health and the Washington State Health Care Authority, to prepare a report on balance billing for ground ambulance services. The statutes defines these services as "organizations licensed by the department of health that operate one or more ground vehicle designed and used to transport the ill and injured and to provide personnel, facilities, and equipment to treat patients before and during transportation."

This survey is designed to gain valuable information to inform the report.




Value & Systems Science Lab (VSSL)



VSSL was created to transform data and ideas into actionable insight about health care systems

A core focus of the Lab is evaluation using:

- Literature Review
- Surveys
- Claims data (Medicare, Medicaid, commercial)
- Advanced statistical methods (difference-in-differences; instrumental variables; regression discontinuity)




Overview of GA Provider Over Survey Surve

Separate questions regarding factors influencing providers' decision to participate versus not participate in commercial health plan network(s)	Survey will separate current question into two separate questions






Provider Feedback	OIC Update
For private ambulance providers, add questions about the corporate ownership of the entity and any	 Changing the provider choices to reflect the following groups: <u>Public</u>: Fire district, city fire dept, city/fire district combination, hospital district, EMS district, municipality (city/county), military, Federal fire dept.
affiliations	 <u>Non-profit</u>: Private volunteer

- association, private non-profit
- <u>Private Equity/publically traded</u>
- <u>Independent</u>: private not publically traded/PE




Provider Feedback	OIC Update
In addition to asking the average amount billed, ask for information about the range of billed charges	Survey will ask for both, averages and range of billed charges






Provider Feedback	OIC Update
Provide a written copy of the financial assistance policy or add option to identify if there is no written policy	Will enable a written copy to be uploaded, in addition to an option to identify if there is no written policy






Provider Feedback	OIC Update
Add questions about agencies staffed 24 hours responding to situations that do not end up in a complete transport, however, utilize all resources like a completed transport	Will factor in based on learnings - we understand responses that do not end with a completed transport are not eligible for billing






Provider Feedback	OIC Update
Reword question around resident waivers to focus first on the providers versus the resident	Survey question will be revised





Provider Feedback	OIC Update
Define cost or cost methodology	Cost definition*: Internal cost of labor, vehicle, and equipment resources used per service.
	*May still adjust this definition based on new information gleaned from $3/31$ meeting






Provider Feedback

OIC Update

Add question that allows providers to raise any ideas they may have to reduce or eliminate surprise billing in ground ambulances.

Add more "open response" fields for any additional comments the providers and may wish to communicate or elaborate on previous responses. Will provide open response/free text options, respectively.
